| <p><b>Traffic Collision with Injuries-</b> August 4<sup>th</sup><br/> <b>Incident Commander:</b><br/>                 Chief Espinosa</p>   | <p>At 10:03 p.m., a traffic collision response was dispatched to the intersection of South Grand Avenue and East Dyer Road in Santa Ana. Fire units arrived on scene and found a single vehicle that had hit a tree. Firefighters identified three patients who had serious injuries. The incident was declared a multi-casualty incident. A total of three paramedic units and three ambulances managed the incident.</p>   |
| <p><b>Structure Fire-</b> August 17<sup>th</sup><br/> <b>Preliminary Cause:</b><br/>                 Intentional<br/> <b>Incident Commander:</b><br/>                 Chief Espinosa</p> | <p>At 11:01 a.m., a structure fire response was dispatched to South Cypress Avenue for a report of a building on fire. The first arriving fire units found a structure with smoke coming from the doors, so firefighters quickly stretched hose lines to extinguish the fire. At 11:18 a.m., crews had managed to control the fire. A civilian, who suffered smoke inhalation, was treated at the scene and was transported to a local area hospital for further treatment.</p>          |
| <p><b>Natural Gas Leak-</b><br/>                 August 22<sup>nd</sup><br/> <b>Incident Commander:</b><br/>                 Chief Espinosa</p>  | <p>At 8:28 a.m., Orange County Fire Authority units were dispatched to a construction site near South Harbor Blvd. Fire units arrived to find a large diameter natural gas line that was inadvertently damaged by workers. Firefighters and Santa Ana Police officers evacuated a portion of the Bali High Mobile Home Park adjacent to the leak, and gas service was interrupted to homes and businesses in the area. The gas leak was secured and there were no reported injuries.</p> |
