September 11th Day of Remembrance



The 15th Anniversary Day of Remembrance ceremony was held at OCFA Headquarters in Irvine on Sunday morning. SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS

Structure Fire September 15	At 5:05 A.M., OCFA units were dispatched to a report of smoke near South Main St. The first unit arrived in approximately five minutes to find a series of enclosed garages on fire. The fire was controlled in 10 minutes and damage was limited to the three garages and contents. There were no injuries to firefighters or apartment occupants. The occupants were not displaced and fire investigators are working to determine the cause.
Structure Fire– September 15	At 10:22 P.M., a call was received about a structure fire on North Tustin Avenue. Firefighters found a two-story apartment complex with smoke showing and began to investigate. The fire was found in the wall of one of the units and additional units were requested. The fire was quickly under control in 15 minutes.
